

Operating procedures

Show it where the wires are and you will be free elsewhere.

[1] On startup, the brake is applied. Press the **GO** button to release it.

[2] Programming a work zone under wires

- Rotate to the start of the zone under the wires.
- Raise the boom to the desired height. (See notes)
- Press the **RED** button.
- Go under the wires to the end of the zone.
- Press the **RED** button.
- You have **5 seconds** to lower the boom.
(Repeat [2] to program up to 3 zones of different heights)

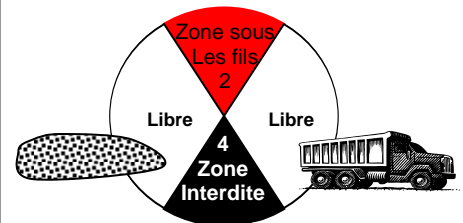
[3] Programming 360° ceiling

- Raise the boom the desired height (See notes).
- Press the **RED** button.
- Lower the boom without turning.
- Press the **RED** button.

[4] Programming a work zone with no height limit.

- Rotate to the start of the work zone.
- Press the **BLACK** button.
- Rotate to the end of the work zone.
- Press the **BLACK** button.
- You have **5 seconds** to return.

You can combine [2] & [4] in the same work area.



NOTES

IMPORTANT: During programming

- On a **Backhoe**, keep the boom fully raised.
- On an **Excavator**, keep the boom fully extended.
- All programming is done by pressing twice on the same button. Once at the start and once at the end.
- When auto-braking occurs, press **GO** to release the brake and then you have 5 seconds to return to the safe working zone.
